Notes

- All accents are typed before the base character: \dot{e} is typed **Slash** then **e**.
- To type the grave accent `use the Slash key /. \dot{a} is typed Slash then a.
- The letter 8 is typed with the Semicolon key ;. This letter has both capital 8 and lowercase forms 8. Many fonts do not differentiate the number 8 from the letter 8, while others leave the top of the letter open, as in 8.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Semicolon* ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, **Right-Alt** is either of the **Option** Keys.
 - ▷ single: ' Grave ' Apostrophe
 - ▷ double: "Shift+Left Bracket "Shift+Right Bracket
 - \triangleright single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 \longrightarrow Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - ▷ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
