Notes

- To type the high-tone accent ´ use the **Backquote key** ` after typing the vowel. *á* is typed **a** then **Backquote**.
- To type the nasal accent ˆ use the **Left-Bracket key** [after typing the vowel. *á* is typed **a** then **Left-Bracket**.
- To type the high-nasal accent ˜ use the **Right-Bracket key**] after typing the vowel. *á* is typed **a** then **Right-Bracket**.
- The *ł* (**barred-l**), *ë*, and *?* (**glottal stop**) letters have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac). Dotted-i is also available using Right-Alt+i or Option+i
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Backquote — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double ‹‹ Right-Alt+9 — ›› Right-Alt+0
