- Where a punctuation key has been remapped, hold down the RIGHT-ALT or OPTION key and type the punctuation. For example, the semicolon ; is typed RIGHT-ALT+; (Windows) or OPTION+; (Mac).
- Accents are typed after the base letter.
 - Apostrophe accent ' : SLASH key. The regular spacing apostrophe is on the APOSTROPHE key.
 - Underline accent _ : SEMICOLON key.
 - The optional acute accent ´ : SHIFT+6
- An alternate way of typing the underline accented letters is to hold down the RIGHT-ALT or OPTION key while pressing either a, g, k, or x. 'A' can be typed RIGHT-ALT+A (Windows), OPTION+A (Mac), or using the underline accent key (SEMICOLON).
- Proper opening and closing quotation marks have special keys.
 - "Double quotes" are SHIFT+HYPHEN and SHIFT+EQUALS.
 - 'Single quotes' are GRAVE and APOSTROPHE
 - «Double guillemets» are RIGHT-ALT+9 and RIGHT-ALT+0 (Windows) or OPTION+9 and OPTION+0 (Mac).
 - ‹Single guillemets› are SHIFT+RIGHT-ALT+9 and SHIFT+RIGHT-ALT+0 (Windows) or SHIFT+OPTION+9 and SHIFT+OPTION+0 (Mac).
