## Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: *é* is typed **e** then **Grave `**.
- To type the acute accent *á* use the **Grave key `**. *á* is typed **a** then **Grave `**.
- To type the glottalized accent *ʔ* use the **Apostrophe key ' .** *kʔ* is typed **k** then **Apostrophe ' .**
- On the keymap above, where two characters are shown on one alphabetic key, the right-hand letter is accessed with the **Shift key**. *w* is **Shift+w**, and *ε* is **Shift+e**.
- Capital letters are typed using the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. Capital *A* is **Right-Alt+a / Option+a**. Capital *Æ* is **Right-Alt+Shift+a / Option+Shift+a**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Semicolon ;* is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ‘ Shift+Grave — ’ Shift+Comma
  - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equal
  - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
