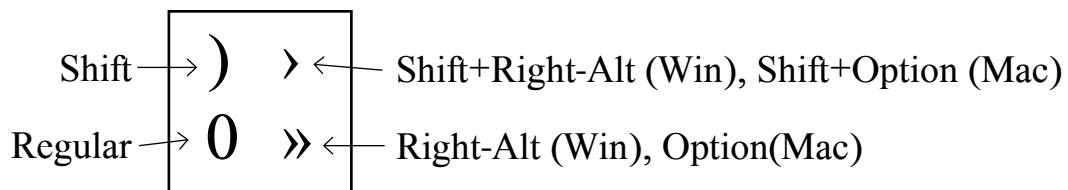


Stáimcets Layout

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Notes

- The **Apostrophe key** ' is the *glottal accent*, as in p̣ ṭ etc.
- The **Semicolon key** ; is the *acute accent*, as in á ú etc.
- The **Grave key** ` is the *grave accent*, as in à è etc. This character is occasionally used for linguistic purposes.
- The **Shift+period key** > is the *mid-dot*. This can be used to separate digraphs into their component characters.
- The **Slash key** / types the *glottal stop* 7. This is a more convenient placing than the number key; either can be used.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the Right-Alt or Option key. The semicolon ; is typed Right-Alt+Semicolon (Windows) Option+Semicolon (Mac).
 - Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Grave — ’ Shift+Comma
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
