## **Notes**

- The Apostrophe key ' is the glottal accent, as in p' t etc.
- The Semicolon key; is the acute accent, as in á ú etc.
- The Grave key `is the grave accent, as in à è etc. This character is occasionally used for linguistic purposes.
- The **Shift+period key** > is the *mid-dot*. This can be used to separate digraphs into their component characters.
- The **Slash key** / types the **glottal stop** 7. This is a more convenient placing than the number key; either can be used.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the Right-Alt or Option key. The semicolon; is typed Right-Alt+Semicolon (Windows) Option+Semicolon (Mac).
  - Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - □ single: 'Shift+Grave —' Shift+Comma
  - □ double: "Shift+Left-Bracket "Shift+Right-Bracket
  - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
