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Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: è is typed e then **Left-Bracket** [.
- To type the low-tone accent ` use the **Left-Bracket** key [. à is typed a then **Left-Bracket** [.
- To type the diæresis accent ¨ use the **Shift+Left-Bracket** key. ě is typed c then **Shift+Left-Bracket**.
- To type the under-dot accent ˙ use the **Right-Bracket** key]. ñ is typed n then **Right-Bracket**].
- To type the ligature accent ˆ use the **Shift+Right-Bracket** key. ññ is typed n then **Shift+Right-Bracket** then n.
- To type the háček accent ˇ use the **Semicolon** key /. ě is typed g then **Semicolon** ;.
- To type the glottalized accent ʼ use the **Slash** key /. k is typed k then **Slash** /.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key. The **Semicolon** ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Grave — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
