

Yellowknives Syllabics Keyboard Layout



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Notes

- Some of the syllabics finals may be ambiguous on the map above:
 - ▶ The w-dot is on the **backquote key**, as in ¹ - not to be confused with the period .
 - ▶ The p-final is on the **shift-W key**, as in ^P - the ejective diacritic is on the **slash key**, as in [/]
 - ▶ The k-final is on the **shift-R key**, as in ^R - the nasal diacritic is on the **z key**, as in ^Z
 - ▶ The m-final is on the **shift-Y key**, as in ^Y - the aspirate diacritic is on the **x key**, as in ^X
 - ▶ The y-final is on the **shift-P key**, as in ^P - not to be confused with the plus-sign ±
 - ▶ For convenience, the t-final is on the **m key** as well as on the **shift-E key**, as in ^E
- On Macs, when the **CAPS-LOCK** is turned on, the keyboard reverts to a US English layout.
- By holding down the **Right-Alt key (Windows)** or **Option key (Mac)**, it is possible to access the numbers and punctuation marks as mapped on a US English keyboard.
