


# Chikashshanompa' (Chickasaw) Keyboard

## Notes

- Accents are typed after the base character: *q* is typed **a** then **Semicolon** ;
- To type the underline accent \_ use the **Semicolon key** ; — *i* is typed **i** then ; Always use this key to type the underline accent; **never** use your word processor's underline formatting function.
- To type the acute accent ' use the **Left-Bracket key** [ — *á* is typed **a** then [
- To type the underline-acute accent ' use the **Shift+Left-Bracket key** { — *á* is typed **a** then {
- To type the circumflex accent ^ use the **Right-Bracket key**] — *â* is typed **a** then ]
- To type the underline-circumflex accent ^ use the **Shift+Right-Bracket key**} — *â* is typed **a** then }
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon** ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ' Grave — ' Apostrophe
  - double: " Shift+Hyphen — " Shift+Equals
  - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
