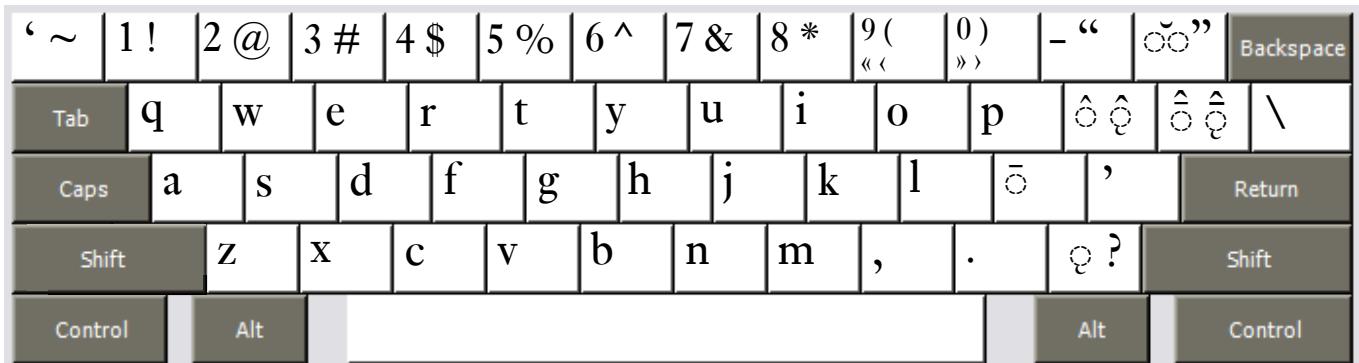


Maskoke (Greek) Keyboard Layout



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Notes

- Accents are typed after the base character: **q** is typed **a** then **Slash /**
- To type the nasal (ogonek) accent **¸** use the **Slash key /** — **ı** is typed **i** then **/**
- To type the circumflex accent **^** use the **Left-Bracket key [** — **â** is typed **a** then **[**
- To type the nasal-circumflex accent **^** use the **Shift+Left-Bracket key {** — **î** is typed **i** then **{**
- To type the circumflex-macron **^** use the **Right-Bracket key]** — **â** is typed **a** then **]**
- To type the nasal-circumflex-macron **^** use the **Shift+Right-Bracket key }** — **î** is typed **i** then **}**
- To type the diphthong-breve accent **ˇ** use the **Equals key =** — **ao** is typed **a** then **=** then **o**
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Slash /** is typed **Right-Alt+Slash** (Windows) **Option+Slash** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Grave (Backquote) — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0 ̄o a
