Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: \hat{e} is typed e then **Grave** `.
- To type the grave accent `use the Grave key `. \hat{a} is typed a then Grave `.
- To type the acute accent 'use the Slash key /. \acute{a} is typed a then Slash /.
- The letters \mathbf{d} and \mathbf{t} each have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, **Right-Alt** is either of the **Option** Keys.
 - ▶ single: 'Shift+Grave 'Apostrophe
 - b double: "Right-Alt+7 "Right-Alt+8
 - single ← Right-Alt+Shift+9 → Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - b double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
