


# Yavapai Keyboard Layout

## Notes

- To type the acute accent ' use the **Right-Bracket key**Right Bracket.
- To type the ligatured d, dd, use the **Slash key** / between the two d's. dd is typed d then **Slash** then d.
- The **ñ (n-tilde)**, **p**, **đ** and the optional **’** letters have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key. The **Semicolon** ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ‘ Shift+6 — ’ Apostrophe
  - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
  - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
